1. Will you need OPCM to pick up or deliver your boat at the launch?

NO: skip this step and move to #2.

YES: determine the launch we will use. See our transport list of launch / de-launch sites and multiply the rate by 2. (This will be for the fall de-launch and the spring launch of your watercraft).

2. Will you need OPCM to winterize your watercraft?

Note: For boats stored on OPCM property, winterization includes a spring start. For boats not stored on OPCM property there is an additional charge for spring start up the following spring.

3. Are you storing on OPCM property?

NO: skip this step and move to #4.

YES: do you prefer inside storage or outside storage?

Our storage structure is based on the length (including the engine) of the boat, the width (if over 8 foot) and weather or not the boat stays on a trailer. Please see our WINTER STORAGE rate sheet to determine what is needed for your boat. In some cases savings can be obtained by removing boats from trailers.

Outside storage is \$250. Shrink Wrap is an additional \$16 per foot (from the tip of the bow to the back of the engines outdrive).

This is the cost of winterization for the season and is due in full by December 31st of the same year.

Late fees apply on January 1st.

Do you have repair orders for your watercraft? If so, we need these orders before winter storage so we may address them and determine if repairs can be done before winter or in the coming spring. Repair orders given in fall, do not guarantee completion before scheduling out in the spring. A minimum TWO WEEK NOTICE is REQUIRED prior to WINTER STORAGE and prior to SPRING OUT.

Customers must have boats ready for storage, including mooring covers, this is not OPCM's responsibility.

Customers with hard top canopies are charged the current labor rate for take down and assembly.

If batteries or keys are removed and not made accessible for our service technicians we charge 0.25 hours of labor.

A PAID \$100 non-refundable deposit is required to store any watercraft inside.
